BROOKLYN—J. Henry Figi, 76, Brooklyn farmer, died Tuesday at a Madison hospital from injuries received when he slipped on the ice at his home about a week ago.

Born in New Glarus, he had been a resident of the Brooklyn area for the past 27 years. He was a member of the Monticello lodge of Masons.
