

Hannah G. Flood

Aug. 21, 1874 - Jan. 18, 1976

Mrs. Hannah G. Flood, 101, rural Brooklyn, died on Sunday, Jan. 18 at Stoughton Community Hospital after a brief illness.

She was born Aug. 21, 1874, at rural Mt. Horeb. She was the daughter of Patrick and Johanna Danniher Gallagher. She was a nurse before her marriage to Martin P. Flood on Feb. 27, 1906. The couple farmed in Brooklyn township, Green County. He died on Jan. 20, 1952.

She was a member of St. James Catholic Church at Dayton and the Altar Society. She formerly was a member of the Jug Prairie Mothers Club.

She is survived by five sons, Martin J., Madison, Raymond of Albany, Gordon, Beloit, Ralph, rural Brooklyn, and Harold, Chicago; three daughters, Miss Bernadine Flood, Janesville, Mrs. Pearl Veith, Waterloo, and Mrs. Arthur Mosher, rural Evansville; 16 grandchildren and 15 great-grandchildren.
