## Mrs. Diet. Freitag, 82, Dies Suddenly; Rites Held Tuesday

Funeral services for Mrs. Dietrich Freitag, 82 years of age, who died unexpectedly of a heart attack in her home here Saturday morning, were held at 1:30 Tuesday afternoon at the Zwingli United Church of Christ here.
