Funeral Tomorrow For Mrs. Gatermann

Funeral services will be held tomorrow at 2 o'clock in the Zwingli-Evangelical and Reformed church, Monticello, for Mrs. Emma Gatermann, 66, wife of Rev. John Gatermann, who died at Ocala, Fla. Friday evening about midnight. Mrs. Gatermann and her husband had been spending the winter in Florida. She suffered a stroke early in the winter. She has been in failing health since.

Emma Heuer, daughter of Henry and Henrietta Heuer, was born in Dale, Wis., Aug. 20, 1878, and attended public schools there. After her marriage to Rev. John Gatermann. at Dale, July 8, 1895, they made their home at different cities in Iowa while he held pastorates there.

She was active in church work in those cities, being president of the many of the ladies societies. While her husband held a charge at the Mission house, Plymouth, Wis., Mrs. Gatermann acted as house mother. They also lived in South Dakota, Barneveld and Sheboygan county. The Gatermanns had been residents of Monticello for about five years.

Surviving beside the husband are one brother, John Heuer, Oshkosh; and a sister, Mrs. A. Muehlmeler, Monticello. Her parents, five brothers and two sisters are deceased.

While serving as pastor's wife in the parish Mrs. Gatermann often times was church organist and possessing, a pleasing alto voice was a member of the church choirs. She was a member of the Evangelical and Reformed church of Monticello and a member of the Ladies' Aid society.

The body will be at the Voegeli funeral home until noon Thursday when it will be taken to the church to lie in state until the time of the funeral.

Funeral services will be held at 2 p. m. Thursday in the Zwingli Evangelical and Reformed church, the Rev. A. R. Achtemeier officiating. Burial will be in Highland cemetery.
