

## **Ada Haney**

**March 21, 1880 - March 28, 1952**

### **Mrs. John Haney Taken by Illness**

Mrs. John Haney, 72, Sylvester township, died here yesterday afternoon following a cerebral hemorrhage. She had been ill two years.

Mrs. Haney was born in Sylvester township March 21, 1880, the daughter of Leonard and Barbara Stauffacher Norder. She was married March 18, 1929, in Monroe.

In an interview with The Times in 1946, Mrs. Haney said she had "done everything but rob a bank." She had a long-standing hobby of collecting odd stones, bits of fossil, arrowheads and any other items which may have had historical significance.

She also found time on the couple's farm home in Sylvester township to knit, tat, crochet, embroider, and keep house.

In addition to her husband, Mrs. Haney leaves two sisters, Mrs. George Vance, New Richmond, and Mrs. C. J. Eliason, Juda; a brother, Frederick, Westby, two nieces and two nephews.

Her father died in August, 1941, and her mother in August, 1950. A sister, Emma Magdaline, preceded her in death in 1907.

Mrs. Haney was a member of the former Dutch Hollow Evangelical church. Services will be held at 1:30 p. m. Monday at the Shriner - Neushwander funeral home, Rev. L. A. Brown officiating. Burial will be in the Dutch Hollow cemetery.
