Royal "Roy" Hawkins, 64, Monticello, died Monday, March 12, 1990, at St. Mary's Hospital, Madison.

Born April 2, 1925, in Avon Township, Rock County, he was the son of Roy and Mildred (Robertson) Hawkins.

On May 4, 1957, he married Helen Stauffacher. He had been employed at General Motors, Janesville, for 32 years and retired Oct. 1, 1987. He and his wife lived in rural Monticello until 1970, before moving into the village.
