

Fred A. Hefty
1868 - March 19, 1936

MONROE — Funeral services for Fred A. Hefty, 72, former Green county resident, who died Thursday at his home in Cedar Rapids, Ia., will be held at 2 p. m. Tuesday at the Shriner-Neushwander funeral home with the Rev. P. A. Schuh officiating. Burial will be at Monticello.

Born at New Glarus, the son of Mr. and Mrs. Abraham Hefty, he married Magdalena Jenny in Jefferson township in 1884. He lived on Green county farms until his wife died in 1900, when he moved to Cedar Rapids where he became associated with a wholesale tea and coffee firm.

Surviving him are five sisters, Mrs. Anna Pfund, Mrs. Anton Jenny, Mrs. Martha Ohls, and Mrs. Mina Pfund, all of Monroe, and Mrs. Matilda Schroeder, Freeport; two brothers, Edward, Denver, Colo., and John, Crosby, N. D.

He was confirmed in St. John's church, and was a member of the Knights of Pythias and the Yeomen.
