Feb. 7, 1879 - April 1, 1964
Rites Held Saturday For Mrs. Hefty, 85

Mrs. Margaret Hefty, 85 years of age, New Glarus, died on Wednesday of last week at a Monroe nursing home after a long illness.

Funeral services were held at 1:30 Saturday afternoon in the Zentner funeral home, New Glarus. The Rev. Linus Wierwill of the Swiss United Church of Christ, officiated, and burial was in the Swiss Evangelical and Reformed cemetery.

She was born Feb. 7, 1879, in Elm, Canton Glarus, Switzerland. When she was a small child she was brought to Monticello. She was the foster daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Rudolph Hoesly, Monticello. On March 29, 1898, she was united in marriage to J. Jacob D. Hefty. They operated the Hefty homestead farm, south of New Glarus, moved to the village for a few years, and then farmed south of Belleville.

Mrs. Hefty was a member of the Swiss church and its Ladies Aid society.

Surviving are a son, Lee, Watertown; a daughter-in-law, Mrs. Edna Hefty, New Glarus, widow of a son, Wilbert, who died in July, 1937; six grandchildren, and 10 great-grandchildren.
