

Augusta Hess
June 10, 1885 - Oct. 12, 1968
Mrs. Hess, 83, Taken by Death

A former Monroe and Green County resident, Mrs. Augusta Hess, 83, Dodgeville, died at 9:45 a.m. Saturday, Oct. 12, in a Dodgeville hospital. Old age complications were fatal after several years of failing health.

The former Augusta Schadewaldt was born in Germany June 10, 1885, a daughter of Gustav and Marie Abe Schadewaldt. She attended Green Valley rural school in Cadiz Township. After she was married to Joseph Hess they farmed in Sylvester Township until his death. She then moved to Monroe and later to Dodgeville where she was in a nursing home.

Surviving are a daughter, Mrs. M. L. (Marie) Miller, Pasadena, Calif., who is to arrive here today; four brothers, Fred Schadewaldt, Hagerstown, Md.; Henry, Dakota, Ill.; Kurt, Orfordville, and Gustav, Cadiz Township, and three sisters, Mrs. Alma Niederberger, Monroe; Mrs. Rubin Thomas, Pasadena, Calif., and Mrs. Rolland Baker, Winslow, Ill.

She was preceded in death by her husband; two brothers, Charles, Monroe, and Emil, Freeport, and a sister, Anna, Monroe, as well as the parents.

Services will be at 1:30 p.m. Tuesday, Oct. 15, in the Stuessy Funeral Home of Monroe. Burial is to be in Dutch Hollow Cemetery.
