Emanuel Hess, aged 33, cheesemaker at the Exeter factory until five weeks ago, died Sunday morning at the home of his sister, Mrs. Jacob Kummer, just north of Monticello. He was ill for eight weeks and came to the home of his sister three weeks ago.

He was born in Switzerland Oct. 22, 1899 and came to this country in 1921. The past nine years he has made cheese. This year his Limburger won first prize at the recent state cheesemakers convention in Milwaukee, and he had won several other awards.

In 1926, Mr. Hess married Martha Gerber, who died two years ago. Surviving are three sons, all of whom live with relatives. Three brothers and two sisters in Switzerland and Mrs. Kummer survive him.

Funeral services were conducted Tuesday by Rev. A. Muehlmeier, at Monticello.
