Anton Hoesly, Aged 77, Dies Monday

Anton H. Hoesly, 77 years of age, Tacoma, Wash. who formerly lived in Monticello, died at 7:15 a. m. Monday at a Tacoma hospital after a short illness.

Mr. Hoesly was born in New Glarus township on the Hoesly homestead farm, Aug. 20, 1876, the son of Rudolph S. and Barbara Stauffacher Hoesly. He was united in marriage Oct. 18, 1898, to Josephine Jordi. They farmed in Green county until 1906, when they moved to Iowa county, where they farmed until 1914. They moved to Eau Claire in 1914. They lived in Monticello from 1948 until 1950, since which time they had made their home in Tacoma with their youngest daughter, Mrs. George Purdue.

Surviving are his wife; two daughters, Mrs. Purdue, and Mrs. Edw. Freitag, Eau Claire; two sons, Howard A., West Allis, and Harold L., Eau Claire; two brothers, Wilbert, Monticello, and Edward, Janesville; and seven grandchildren. He was preceded in death by one sister, Mrs. Edw. Freitag.

Funeral services were held in Tacoma yesterday (Wednesday), after which Mr. Hoesly was brought to Monticello for further services and burial.

Funeral services in Monticello will be held at 2 Sunday afternoon at the Voegeli funeral home. The Rev. A. R. Achtemeier, pastor of the Zwingli Evangelical and Reformed church, will officiate, and burial will be in Highland cemetery. Friends may call at the funeral home after 3 p. m. Saturday.
