Rites are Saturday For Barbara Hoesly
New Glarus' Oldest Dies In Hospital After Hip Is Fractured

Funeral services for Mrs. Barbara Hoesly, 93 years of age, highly respected and esteemed resident of New Glarus and oldest citizen of that village, who passed away Wednesday at the Monroe hospital, were conducted at 2 Saturday afternoon in the Swiss Evangelical and Reformed church, New Glarus.

The Rev. W. J. Stuckey, church pastor, officiated, and burial was in the church cemetery.

Mrs. Hoesly suffered a fractured hip in a fall several weeks ago and had since been hospitalized.

Native of Switzerland

Mrs. Hoesly was born in Canton Glarus, Switzerland, and came to America when she was 18 years of age. Before coming to New Glarus she had lived at Galena, Ill, and Monroe. On Jan. 28, 1874, she was united in marriage to Hilarius Wild, the ceremony taking place in New Glarus. They resided in Adams township for many years. Mr. Wild passed away in 1907 and she later married Joseph Hoesly.

Survivors are three daughters, Mrs. Emanuel Streiff and. Mrs, Larry Klassy, New Glarus, and Mrs. Anna Theiler, Brodhead; four sons, Fred and Robert Wild, New Glarus, John Wild, Granada, Minn. and Edward Wild, Redfield, S. D.
