Rites Held Tuesday For Mrs. Jac. Hoesly

Funeral services for Mrs Jacob B. Hoesly, 73 years of age, New Glarus, a native of Washington township, who died at 9:15 p. m. Saturday in her home, were held at 2 p. m. Tuesday in the Swiss United Church of Christ New Glarus.

The Rev. Lynn F. B. Tschudy, church pastor, officiated, and burial was in the church cemetery. Pallbearers were Wm. and Fred Becker, Palmyra, Jacob Wittenwyler, Monticello, Marx Disch and Emil Wittenwyler, Belleville, and Harry Disch, Madison.

Mrs. Hoesly had been ill for the past year.

Rosina Becker was born June 29, 1884, the daughter of Jacob and Rosina Hefty Becker. She was united in marriage to Jacob B. Hoesly on Dec. 20, 1900, the ceremony taking place in Monticello. Mr. and Mrs. Hoesly farmed in Primrose township, Dane county, until they retired and moved to New Glarus in 1946. They observed their golden wedding anniversary in 1950.

Mrs. Hoesly was a member of the Swiss United Church of Christ, New Glarus, and its Aid society, and the Aid society of the Primrose Lutheran church.

She is survived by her husband; two sons, Clarence H., Belleville, and Clifford, at home.

Mrs. Hoesly was preceded in death by two sisters, Mrs. Henry Hefty and Mrs. Matt B. Wittenwyler, and two brothers, Jacob and John.
