FORMER EVANSVILLE GIRL'S LIFE SAVED BY HUSBAND

A Belleville farmer, Thomas H. Hoesly, 27, gave his life to save his wife, a former Evansville girl, Marie Buehler, last Sunday. He was killed in a collision of two cars on county trunk D. near Belleville. Mrs. Buehler, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. George Buehler said her husband threw himself in front of her when he saw his car was about to collide with the other vehicle. She was treated for minor injuries by a Belleville doctor. Driver of the other car was Darvin G. Esier, 16, route 4, Madison, reported in critical condition at Madison Methodist hospital.

Thomas Hoesly was born in Brooklyn township, the son of Fred and Sarah Voegeli Hoesly. On October 5, 1949, he married Marie Buehler.

The funeral was Wednesday in the Zwingli Evangelical and Reformed church at Monticello, the Rev. A. R. Achtemeier officiating. Burial was in Highland cemetery, Monticello.
