MADISON/ALBANY — Miss Virginia Ann Hoesly age 55, of 318 W. Gorham Street, Madison, died on Monday, September 1, 1975, at the Dane County Nursing Home, Verona, after a long illness.

Born at Monticello on September 8, 1919, she had lived at Albany prior to moving to Madison about 35 years ago. She had been a long time employee of the Ray-O-Vac Company of Madison where she worked as a payroll clerk until illness forced her retirement in November of 1974.
