

Marie Ethel Hoesly-Croft

Feb. 4, 1930 - May 5, 1971

Mrs. Robert Croft, 41, Route 1, Evansville, a former Exeter Township resident, was dead on arrival Wednesday morning, May 5, at the Stoughton hospital. She had had a long illness.

The former Marie Ethel Buehler, daughter of George and Cecelia Kesser Buehler, was born Feb. 4, 1930 in Evansville and graduated from Evansville High School. She was married Nov. 5, 1949 in New Glarus to Thomas Henry Hoesly, a native of Brooklyn Township. He was killed in a traffic accident Sept. 7, 1952, in which she received minor injuries. On Aug. 7, 1954, she married Robert Croft.

Surviving are her husband; a daughter, Karen Ann, at home; and her mother, Mrs. Cecelia Jostad of Cable, Wis.

Her father, George Buehler, died in August 1956. He was a former cheesemaker in the Monroe area and later was a foreman in the tool room at Baker Mfg. Co. in Evansville. Both parents were natives of Switzerland.

Services for Mrs. Croft will be at 11 a.m. Friday, May 7, in the Roderick-Ward Funeral Home in Evansville. Burial will be in Highland Cemetery, Monticello.
