Ira L. Holcomb, 81, Monroe, a former Monticello resident, died Monday Jan. 6, in St. Clare hospital. His funeral was held Thursday, Jan. 9, in the Stuessy funeral home with burial in the Highland Cemetery, Monticello.

Mr. Holcomb was a lifelong Green County resident. He was married to the former Hulda Marty in 1914 and they engaged in farming the Holcomb Homestead west of Monticello until 1935, when they moved to town and owned and operated a tavern until retirement.

He is survived by his widow, Hulda; three daughters, Mrs. Gladys Durst, Monroe, Mrs. Dan (Ruth) Ringhand, New Glarus, and Mrs. Edwin (Alice) Wilde, of Monroe; six brothers Harold, Marvin, Leon, James and Arthur, all of Monroe, and Clarence, Monticello; 11 grandchildren, and 27 great-grandchildren.
