

Cecil L. Holloway
July 14, 1905 - July 8, 1980

Cecil L. Holloway, 74, rural Monroe, died Tuesday, July 8. He was pronounced dead on arrival at St. Clare Hospital where he was taken after an apparent heart attack suffered at his home.

Born in Washington township July 14, 1905, he was the son of Percy and Mary Shank Holloway. On December 28, 1932, he was married to Emmaline Marti, Monroe, in Appleton by Rev. G. H. Blum, former pastor of the Immanuel Evangelical Church, Monroe.

Mr. Holloway and his wife farmed and lived in Washington township. He attended the Simmons School.

Survivors include his wife, Emmaline; one son, Keith, stationed with the U.S. Air Force in Anchorage, Alaska, and three grandchildren.

He was a member of the United Methodist Church in Monroe, the Moose Lodge, Masons, Eastern Star and the Farm Bureau.

Funeral services were held Friday, July 11, at the United Methodist Church, Monroe. The Rev. John Francis officiated. Burial was in Greenwood Cemetery in Monroe.
