Adolf Hurlimann Dies in Rockford

Adolf Hurlimann, 53, Rockford, died at 6 p. m. yesterday at his home following a heart attack. He had been ill for a brief time.

Mr. Hurlimann was born in Frauenfeld, Canton Thurgau, Switzerland, May 5, 1900, a son of Alois and Anna Flammer Hurlimann. He came to this country in 1923 and was a cheesemaker in Green and Lafayette counties before moving to Rockford.

He was married to Margaretha Brugger, Dec. 2, 1920, at St. John's church in Monroe by the late Rev. P. A. Schuh.

Mr. Hurlimann leaves his wife; three sons, Fritz, San Bernardino, Calif., Adolph and Walter, Rockford; and a daughter, Mildred, Rockford, and three sisters in Switzerland.

Preceding him in death were a daughter, Margaret, who died in 1939, and his mother and two brothers who died within the past two years.
