C. H. Isely, Monroe, Succumbs Suddenly Washington Twp. Native Dies Sunday; Final Services Held

Monroe—Christ H. Isely, 66, Monroe, died at his home at 7 p. m. Sunday following an illness of only three days.

Mr. Isely was born in Washington township, Feb. 7, 1877, the son of Mr. and Mrs. Christ Isely. On Nov. 15, 1900, he was married to Marie Mueller at Trent, S. D. He always made his home in this vicinity, the last 18 years in Monroe, where he followed the mason and cement worker's trade. He was confirmed in the Washington Reformed church.

Survivors include his widow; two sons, LeRoy and Walter, at home; a daughter, Mrs. Ray Nordycke, Ainsworth, Iowa; five sisters, Mrs. Carl Marty, Sr., Mrs. Ulrich Rufer, Mrs. Emil Ritschard and Mrs. Fred Ritschard, all of Monroe, and Mrs. Edgar Simmons, Buffalo, Wyo.; two brothers, Jacob, Lindsay, Calif., and William, Washington township; and three grandchildren.

Preceding him in death were three brothers, Sam, George and John Isely, and three sisters, Mrs. Mary Bidlingmaier, Miss Anna Isely and Mrs. Gottfried Waeffler.

Funeral services were held at 2 p.m. Wednesday at the Shriner-Neushwander funeral home. The Rev. Paul C. Kehle, pastor of the St. John's Evangelical and Reformed church, Monroe, officiated, and burial was in Greenwood cemetery.
