

**Karl J. Jacobson**  
**March 21, 1900 – November 16, 1963**  
**Rites Held Tuesday For Karl Jacobson**

Funeral services for Karl J. Jacobson, 63 years of age, Monticello, who died at 7:55 p. m. Saturday in the St. Clare hospital, Monroe, where he had been a patient since Nov. 8, were held at 1:30 Tuesday afternoon at the Voegeli funeral home here.

The Rev. J. Allan Mittler, pastor of the Zwingli United Church of Christ, officiated, and burial was in Highland cemetery. Pallbearers were Walter Flesher, Albany, Karl H. Freitag, William Gibbons, Louis Wyss, Herman Schlittler and John D. Zimmerman.

Mr. Jacobson, a painter and interior decorator by trade, had been in failing health for more than a year and had been hospitalized on several occasions during that time,
