

Edith Irene Jensen
June 4, 1888 - August 12, 1974
Mrs. Jensen, 86, Dies Monday

Mrs. Edith Zentner Jensen, 86, of Richland Center, died Monday morning at a nursing home there. Mrs. Jensen had been a resident of the nursing home for the past six months.

E. Irene Bontly, born June 4, 1888, in York Township, was the daughter of John and Mary Mitchell Bontly, She grew up in Monticello and attended school here.

Mrs. Jensen was married to Oswald E. Zentner in 1908. They farmed in Mt. Pleasant Township until 1945, when they retired to Monroe. Mr. Zentner died Dec. 5, 1950.

In 1952 Mrs. Jensen married Christian Jensen and they lived in Monroe and Stoughton. He died in 1968, and Mrs. Jensen moved to Richland Center to live near a daughter.

Survivors include two daughters, Mrs. M. A. (Laura) Wuilleumier, Richland Center; Mrs. Texel (Sylvia) Glazebrook, Ava, Missouri; one stepdaughter Mrs. Wilbur Smout, Janesville; one stepson Curtis Jensen, Stoughton; one sister Mrs. E. J. Konkol, Madison; three grandchildren and two great-grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by her two husbands, one brother, and two sisters.

Services were held Wednesday, August 14, at the Zwingli Church Memorial Lounge. Rev. Charles G. Workman officiated, and internment was in Highland cemetery.
