

## **Alonzo Preston Jordan**

**Mar. 1840 - 1926**

Mr. and Mrs. Corson Gift were at Albany Thursday for the funeral of the latter's uncle, Mr. Preston Jordan.

A. P. Jordan was nearly 87 years of age. He was born at Ludlow Vt. coming to Wisconsin with his parents when a small boy. His parents were early settlers of Exeter township the home farm of his parents is now owned by F. K. Zweifel two miles south of this village.

Mr. Jordan was a Civil War Veteran, and later married Miss Frances Hunt of this village, who preceded him in death a few years ago. They spent most of their married life on a farm in Exeter where their children grew up and left for homes of their own. They later moved to Dayton, then owing to failing health to Albany to be near their daughter.

Mr. Jordan was a good father, husband and neighbor. He leaves one daughter Mrs. Lizzie Case, of Albany and Charles Jordan of Wheeling W. Va. and many relatives and friends.

The interment was in the family lot at Old Exeter Cemetery which was laid out by the U. S. government in about 1840, and is probably one of the few national cemeteries in Wisconsin.
