Bruce D. Kehm, age 72 of rural Monticello, Wisconsin died Friday, September 9, 2011 at his home. He was born November 25, 1938 at Rockford, Illinois the son of Ralph and Madeline (Eckerson) Kehm and attended Monticello, WI Schools.
