

Blanche A. Kennedy
March 26, 1905 - September 16, 1989

Blanche A. Kennedy, 84, of Monticello, died on Saturday, September 16, 1989, at St. Clare Hospital, Monroe, following an apparent heart attack.

She was born on March 26, 1905, the daughter of Boyd and Alta (Maryott) Young, in Milton Township. She attended the local schools and graduated from Milton-Union High School and worked as a secretary.
