Mrs. Kennett, Madison, Dies

Mrs. C. L. Kennett, 74, a former Green County public school teacher, died yesterday morning in a Madison hospital after a brief illness. She had been a Madison resident since 1935.

Services will be at 11 a.m. Friday in the Frautschi funeral home, 3610 Speedway, Madison, and at 2 p.m. in the Albany Methodist church. Rev. Robert L. Hamill of the Wesley Methodist church, Madison will officiate. Burial will be in the Attica cemetery.

Mrs. Kennett was the former Bessie Cleveland, a native of Attica, and a daughter of the Ben Clevelands. She taught in the U. S. Indian School at Boise, Ida., where she was married in 1913 to Clarence L. Kennett.

She was a member of the Wesley Methodist church, Madison, and the Methodist Hospital Science League.
