Donald F. Klassy, 31, Deerfield, formerly of Monroe, died unexpectedly of an apparent heart attack at his home on Tuesday, April 27.

Born on July 29, 1944, in Monroe, he was the son of Mrs. Alice Escher Klassy and the late Harry Klassy. He graduated from Monroe High School in 1962.
