

## **Charlotte “Lottie” Klassy**

**Feb. 26, 1860 - February 15, 1945**

### **Mrs. Lottie Klassy, Aged 84, Expires After Long Illness Rites Held Saturday P. M. For Life Long Resident Of Community**

Funeral services for Mrs. Lottie Klassy, 84 years of age, life-long resident of Monticello and vicinity, who passed away Thursday in the Methodist hospital, Madison, following a year of failing health, were held at 2 Saturday afternoon at the Voegeli funeral home.

The Rev. W. J. Abie, pastor of Grace Evangelical church, officiated, and burial was in Highland cemetery.

In failing health for a year or more, Mrs. Klassy grew steadily weaker until Feb. 2, when her condition became such that she was removed to the Madison hospital.

Lottie Rolph was a native of New Glarus township and was born Feb. 26, 1860, the daughter of C. F. W. and Mary Anna Trogner Rolph. She received her education in rural schools and was married Oct. 1, 1881, to Jacob Klassy, the ceremony taking place in Albany. They farmed in Mt. Pleasant township, just east of the Monticello railroad depots for many years. Mrs. Klassy moved to Monticello in 1917, her husband having passed away the preceding year.

Surviving are a brother, George Rolph, Postville; and two sisters, Mrs.. Augusta Pierce, Monticello, and Mrs. Ellen Soper, Postville. She was preceded in death by her husband and an infant son; five brothers, William, Fred and Chas. Rolph, Sr., Monticello, John, Oshkosh, and Hiram, Freeport; and three sisters, Mrs. Sarah Dore, Antigo, Miss Emma Rolph and Mrs. Mary Ruegg, Monticello, the latter having passed away last year.
