

Rites Held Tuesday For Mrs. Sylvia Knobel, Age 74

Funeral services for Mrs. Sylvia Knobel, 74 years of age, Monticello, who passed away Sunday morning at St. Clare hospital, Monroe, after a short illness, were held at 2 p. m. Tuesday at the Voegeli funeral home.

The Rev. J. C. Oliphant, traveling pastor of the Zwingli United Church of Christ here, officiated, and burial was in Highland cemetery. Pallbearers were Elmer Freitag, Karl Freitag, C. W. Karlen, Adam Schuler, Paul Staedtler and Frederick Voegeli.

Sylvia Staedtler was born in Milwaukee on Jan. 8, 1885, the daughter of J. Henry and Margaret Wettengel Staedtler. The family moved to Monticello and she attended schools here. On June 14, 1904, she was united in marriage to Fred B. Knobel. Mr. and Mrs. Knobel resided in Monticello, where he was a prominent cheese dealer, being a partner of the late Edw. Wittwer. He passed away Aug. 13, 1918.

Mrs. Knobel lived at the Green county home for many years.

She is survived by three nieces and three nephews, Ruth Abley, Monticello, Monica Staedtler, Arnold and Paul Staedtler, Madison, Mrs. Burt Whitney, and Arthur Stauffacher, Dawson, N. D.
