April 13, 1906 - January 22, 1988

MADISON — Edward J. Konkol, Sr. age 81, died unexpectedly on Friday, January 22, 1988, at Charlotte Harbor, Florida.

He was born on April 13, 1906, in Ashland, Wisconsin. He graduated from University Law School in 1930; practiced law in Wisconsin for 50 years.
