Mrs. Krajeck, Age 52, Area Native, Dies After Long Illness

Funeral services for Mrs. George Krajeck, 52 years of age, Route 1, Brooklyn, who died Thursday night in the Stoughton hospital after a long illness, were held at 1:30 Monday afternoon in the Baptist church in Evansville.

The Rev. Hugh Crandall officiated, and burial was there in Maple Hill cemetery.

Florence Voegeli was born in Exeter township, a few miles northeast of Monticello, a daughter of Thomas and Ida Grunder Voegeli. She graduated from the Monticello high school in 1935. On Feb. 12, 1938, she was united in marriage in the Zwingli United Church of Christ here, to George A. Krajeck. She had lived in the Brooklyn-Evansville area since her marriage.

She was a former member of Zwingli church and was a member of the Butts Corner Community club and had been active in cancer and heart fund drives.

Surviving are her husband; three sons, Donald and Robert, Evansville, and Richard, Oshkosh; a daughter, Mrs. Terry Dohs, rural Evansville; her mother, Mrs. Ida Voegeli, Monticello; a brother, Walter Voegeli, Dodgeville; a sister, Mrs. Elwood V. Schwerts, Rice Lake, and eight grandchildren.
