Mrs. Henry Kubly Sr., 74, route 1, Monticello, died at 10:05 Sunday night at St. Clare hospital.. Old-age complications were fatal. She was bedfast a year and a half and had been a medical patient at the hospital since May 26.

Funeral services will be at 2 Wednesday afternoon in the Zwingli Evangelical and Reformed church, Monticello, of which she was a member. Rev. A. R. Achtemeier, pastor of the church, will officiate and burial will be in Highland cemetery. The body will be taken from the Voegeli funeral home to the church at noon Wednesday.
