Mrs. Maria Kubly, Aged 89, Succumbs; Rites Held Monday Esteemed Local Resident, Native of Switzerland Dies Saturday

Funeral services for Mrs. Maria Kubly, 89 years of age, highly esteemed Monticello resident for many years, who passed away at 4:15 Saturday morning at the home of a daughter, Mrs. Walter Wittenwyler, Mt. Pleasant township, were held at 2 Monday afternoon in the Zwingli Evangelical and Reformed church here.

The Rev. A. R. Achtemeier, church pastor, officiated. Burial was in Highland cemetery. Pallbearers were Alvin Baebler, Henry V. Baebler, John H. Baebler, Dr. Wm. V Raebler. Henry Kubly, Jr. and Wm. Pagel Jr.

Mrs. Kubly had been in failing health for several months and had made her home with her daughter for the past four months.

Native of Switzerland

A native of Canton Glarus, Switzerland, she was born Sept. 10, 1862, the daughter of Vinzenz and Mary Stauffacher Baebler. On Dec. 4, 1883 she was united in marriage to Abraham Kubly, the ceremony taking place in Matt, Canton Glarus. In 1885 Mr. and Mrs. Kubly came to America, coming directly to Green county. They farmed in Jordan township for some time and later acquired a farm in Mt, Pleasant township, about two miles east of Monticello. They retired from farming in 1909 and came to Monticello to make their home.

Mrs. Kubly was a devoted member of the Zwingli Evangelical and Reformed church.

Possessed of an unusually buoyant and pleasant disposition, "Grandma" Kubly was always held in the highest esteem by all who knew her. She was a friend of young and old alike and her passing was occasioned by deep regret by all of her many friends.

A tireless worker, she enjoyed her garden and flowers and spent many hours in her garden, even during the past summer at the age of 89.

She is survived by three daughters, Mrs. Matt H.
