

Marie Lemon
Sept. 24, 1885 - Feb. 9, 1963
Mrs. Lemon, Monroe, Dies

Mrs. Marie (Mary) Lemon, 77, of 503 20th avenue, died at 5:55 this morning in St. Clare hospital. She had been hospitalized since Jan. 16 and in ill health for several years.

She was the former Marie Loertscher, daughter of Gottfried and Alvina Goecks Loertscher, born Sept. 24, 1885, in Washington Township. On Feb. 27, 1906, she was married to William W. Lemon. They farmed before building a house and moving to Monroe in 1949.

Mrs. Lemon was a member of Immanuel Evangelical United Brethren church.

There are no immediate survivors, other than five nephews. Her husband died May 20, 1953. She was also preceded in death by two brothers, Frank and Charles Loertscher, and a sister, Mrs. Christ Roth.

Services will be at 1 p.m. Wednesday in Immanuel church. Rev. Karl F. Koch, pastor, and Rev. Burton L. Holling of Bethel EUB church will officiate. Burial will be in Greenwood cemetery.

The body will be taken to the church at 10 a.m. Wednesday for further visitation. Friends may call at the funeral home after noon on Tuesday.
