

**Verena “Fannie” Lewis**  
**June 1878 - April 18, 1946**  
**Mrs. Fannie Lewis, 68; Dies at Dousman**

Mrs. Fannie Lewis, 68, widow of Amza Lewis, Exeter township and Monticello vicinity resident, died Thursday at the Masonic Home at Dousman, where she had lived since Feb. 14.

Mrs. Lewis had been ill the past year of a heart ailment.

The former Fannie Disch came here from Switzerland with her mother and several brothers when a young woman. The family settled at New Glarus. She married Amza Lewis and they lived many years on the Lewis farm in Exeter. Mr. Lewis died several years ago; also a son LeRoy and two small children, besides her parents, several brothers and sisters.

Immediate survivors are three grandchildren, children of her son LeRoy, living in Madison, two brothers, Casper Disch, New Glarus, and a brother living in Switzerland and a sister, Mrs. Barbara Wischer, Beloit.

Funeral services were held Saturday at the Becker Funeral home at Belleville and in Zwingli Reformed church, with Rev. H. A. Norenberg, pastor of the church, officiating. Burial was in the Exeter cemetery.
