Hospital Matron Taken by Death

Albany—Mrs. Jesse Lewis, 43, resident of Albany until seven years ago, died Sunday at her home in Fletcher, N. C., following an operation. She had been matron at the Mountain Sanatorium and hospital there the past three years.

Formerly Flora Templeton, she was married to Jesse Lewis, June 19, 1913. Mr. Lewis died in 1926. Surviving are a son, Harland, of Fletcher, N. C.; her mother, Mrs. T. A. Templeton, a sister, Mrs. Frank Schuyler and a brother, John, all of Sturgeon Bay; and a brother, L. W. Lewis of Albany.

The body will be brought here to the home of her father-in-law, Silas Lewis. Funeral arrangements have not been completed, but burial will be in Exeter cemetery.
