

Helen Mehitable Lewis
August 24, 1856 - March 9, 1916

Helen Mehitable Ross was born in the town of Exeter, Green county, Wisconsin, August 24, 1856. In 1866 she came with her parents to the village of Attica, Here she received her education and in 1874 taught in the public 'school.

February 17, 1875 she was united in marriage to John Lewis, of the town of Mt. Pleasant. To this union twelve children were born, four of whom preceded her to the better land, Grace, Chester, Orrin and Nellie.

August 15, 1911 she suffered a stroke of paralysis and has since been unable to walk. From October 1915 she gradually grew worse and March 9, 1916 she passed to the great beyond, aged 59 years 6 months and 15 days.

Her husband and eight children, Idell, Pearl, Lester, Edith, Ethel, Walter and Hazel, who are still at home and Albert of Exeter township, are left to mourn the loss of a faithful wife and mother. Four sisters and one brother also survive her.

Services were held at the home and at the church in Attica, by Rev. Fred J. Jordan, Saturday March 11, 1916. Interment in Attica cemetery.
