Rites Held for Silas Loveland, Brodhead

Washington Twp. Native Victim of Heart Trouble At Home of Nephew

Funeral services for Silas E. Loveland, 78 years of age, a native of Washington township and a resident of Brodhead for the past 22 years, who passed away Thursday afternoon in the home of a nephew, Atty. W. A. Loveland, Monticello, following an illness of several days duration with heart trouble, were conducted at 2:30 Sunday afternoon in the Everson funeral home, Brodhead.

Rev. J. C. Robertson, pastor of the Congregational church, Brodhead, officiated, and burial was in the Exeter township cemetery.

Silas Loveland was born in Washington township Aug. 19, 1865, a son of Argalus and Jane Orvig Loveland. He was united in marriage Feb. 25, 1897, to Ellen Lewis, the ceremony taking place in Monticello. For three years they farmed on the Loveland homestead farm in Washington township, now known as the Adolph Arn farm. Leaving here they moved to Corona, S. D. In 1921 they returned to Green county and located at Brodhead. Mrs. Loveland passed away in August, 1936.

Mr. Loveland was a member of the Odd Fellows lodge at Corona.

Mr. Loveland was the last member of a family of six girls and eight boys. Only nieces and nephews survive.
