Alonzo Lynn, Aged 74, Monroe, Passes Native of Exeter Twp. was Former Teacher and Farmer Here

Alonzo Lynn, 74, a Monroe resident since 1916, died at 12:10 p.m. Friday in a Monroe hospital. He had been ill for some time.

Mr. Lynn was born in Exeter township June 4, 1867. He attended schools in Monticello and Monroe, and was a normal school graduate. After teaching in the Monticello vicinity several years, he farmed on the Lynn homestead in Exeter township. He came to Monroe in 1916, purchasing a house at 906 24th avenue. He was a member of St. Victor's church.

Funeral services were conducted Monday at 9 a. m. at the Knight funeral home in Monroe and at 9:30 a. m. at St. Victor's church, the Rev. E. C. McCollow officiating. Burial was in Highland cemetery, Monticello.

Mr. Lynn was an uncle of M. E. Lynn, Monticello.
