John Mahar 1875 - May 16, 1893 A Fatal Race.

Monticello, Wis., May 16.—John Mahar, aged about 19, residing in the town of Exeter, five miles northeast of here, was killed while he and his brothers were racing horses. The forward wheel of the wagon struck a gate post, throwing him off the wagon head first against the wheel and crushing his skull. He died instantly.
