Herman Malcook Succumbs at 74

Brodhead — (Special)— Herman Malcook, 74, a lifelong resident of Green county, died at 10 yesterday morning at his farm, south of Brodhead, from a sudden heart attack.

Born in Decatur township, May 16, 1874, he was the son of William and Sophia Coplien Malcook. He was married in 1905 to Lena Brown who passed away two years later. On Jan. 21, 1909, he was married at Dutch Hollow. to Lydia Recia.

Mr. Malcook was a member of the Evangelical United Brethren church of Brodhead.

Surviving are the widow; five daughters, Mrs. Gerald Zimmerman, Mrs. Pearl Gadow, Mrs. Fred Lentz, Mrs. Alfred Gadow, and Mrs. Ralph Schwartz, all of Brodhead vicinity; four sons, Harold, Oconomowoc; Raymond, Roy and Floyd, Brodhead vicinity; a half-sister, Mrs. Lena Laufmann, Beatrice, Neb.: 21 grandchildren. Two brothers and a sister preceded him.

Funeral services will be held at 1:30 Thursday afternoon in the Evangelical' United Brethren church. Rev. F. W. Huebner, retired minister, will officiate and burial will be in Dutch Hollow cemetery, northeast of Monroe. Friends may call Wednesday evening at the Everson funeral home.
