Funeral services for Christ H. Marti, 79 years of age, a resident of Monticello for the past several years, who passed away in the Monroe hospital Sunday following a long illness, were held at 2 Wednesday afternoon in the Stuessy funeral home, Monroe.

Following the death of his wife, Mr. Marti made his home with members of his family for a number of years, but for the past few years he had been a resident of Monticello.

Mr. Marti was born in Switzerland and came to America with his parents when he was but seven years of age. He attended schools in Monroe and Jordan townships.

Mrs. Marti passed away in 1937. He was a member of the Immanuel Evangelical church, Monroe, and old Company H of the national guard.

Possessed of a buoyant and pleasant disposition, Mr. Marti acquired the friendship and respect of a large number of acquaintances in the Monticello community, all of whom were deeply grieved upon learning of his death.
