

Anna Marty
May 30, 1892 - April 12, 1981

Mrs. Matt A. (Anna) Marty, 88, former New Glarus resident died April 12 at the Mt. Horeb Nursing Home.

The former Anna Arnold was born on May 30, 1892, in Altdorf, Switzerland. She came to the United States in 1910 and was married to Matt A. Marty on Oct. 17, 1912. They farmed in the Monticello area from 1912 to the mid-40's and then moved to New Glarus. They had lived in New Glarus until moving to Belleville in 1957.

She was a member of the GUGG Society and St. Mary of Lourdes Catholic Church, Belleville.

Survivors include five daughters, Mrs. Glenn (Clara) Nybrotten, Monticello, Mrs. Murl (Violet) Cliff, Chippewa Falls. Mrs. Leona Huseth and Mrs. Clifford (Palma) Mueller, both of Mt. Horeb, and Mrs. Robert (Gloria) Jacobson, New Glarus; two sons, Arnold, Durham, N.H., and Leon, Albany: one brother, Adolph, and one sister, Franci, Altdorf, Switzerland; 19 grandchildren; 39 great-grandchildren; and one great-great-grandchild.

Her husband preceded her in death on Jan. 6, 1974; one grandchild, Lucy Ann, on Oct. 30, 1957; brothers, Carl and Ambrose Arnold; one brother on the Titanic; and six brothers in Switzerland; one sister, Mrs. Frank Tresch, and three sisters in Switzerland.

Funeral services were held today (Wednesday) April 15 at St. Mary of Lourdes Catholic Church, Belleville: Rev. Leo Joyce officiated and burial was in St. James Catholic Cemetery, Dayton.
