Feb. 20, 1905 - June 18, 1979

Mrs. M. Albert (Eileen) Marty, 74, rural Monticello, died Monday, June 18 at the Monroe hospital, where she had been a patient for the past two weeks.

The daughter of John and Edith Schuelte Davenport, she was born Feb. 20, 1905 in Milwaukee. She attended the Gesu Parochial School in Milwaukee. She married M. Albert Marty, and had lived in Milwaukee, Lake Mills and Jefferson before moving to rural Monticello in 1951.

She was a member of the St. James Catholic Church and the Altar Society in Dayton, and the Mt. Pleasant Homemakers.

Funeral services were held Wednesday, June 20, in St. Mary of Lourdes Catholic Church in Belleville. Rev. Raymond Runde officiated and burial was in Highland Cemetery, Monticello.

Survivors include her husband, one daughter, Mrs. Jerry (Joyce) Wittenwyler, Beloit; two sons, Norman of Cascade and David of Beloit; a half-brother, Floyd Taylor of Oakland, Cal., and nine grandchildren. She was preceded in death by her parents and one son, Marvin, in 1966.
