

Jacob F. Marty, Monticello Native, Dies in Nebraska

NEW GLARUS—Jacob F. Marty, native of Washington township and a former proprietor of the New Glarus hotel, died recently at his home in Marshfield Neb., after an illness from bronchial pneumonia, according to word received here by relatives. Mr. Marty, who had lived in Green county his entire life with the exception of 12 years spent in the west, was a son of the late Mr. and Mrs. Melchior Marty, who were among the early settlers of Washington township. He was one of a large family of children, all of whom have preceded him in death except two sisters, Mrs. Anna Karlen and Mrs. Louise Klassy, both of Monticello.

Other survivors are a son, Herman Marty, Madison, and a married daughter, Mata, who lives at Marshfield, Wis.
