John Casper Marty Sept. 25th, 1855 - April 15, 1915

John Casper Marty, proprietor of the New Glarus Hotel, passed away Thursday at 5 o'clock A. M.

The deceased was born on Sept. 25th, 1855 at Brookfield, Waukesha Co. and came to Washington township in 1865. He was united in marriage with Miss Rosa Hefty on the 5th of April, 1883, For many years they engaged in farming on the well-known Marty farm in Washington township, until March 1914 when they came to this village and took possession of the New Glarus Hotel.

The union was blessed with 11 children of which one boy died. Mr, Marty has been ailing with rheumatism for a number of years and has visited several sanitariums on account of it. He has been confined to his bed for about four weeks.

Mr. Marty lived practically all his life in Washington township, which he served for many years as chairman and supervisor. He was also well-known as a breeder of Holstein Friesian cattle.

He is survived by his widow, four sons, Fred, Edward, Jacob and Walter Marty, and six daughters, Mrs. Herman Legler, Mrs. Gessler of Riley, Mrs. Robert Holcomb, Mrs. Ira Holcomb, Sylvia and Norma Marty.

The funeral will be held next Sunday afternoon at 2 o'clock in Monticello and 12:30 o'clock from his home at New Glarus.
