Mrs. Julia Miller, 67, Passes On; Services To be Held Today Heart Disease is Fatal to Former Local Lady Early Monday

Mrs. Julia Miller, 67 years of age, a former resident of Mt. Pleasant township and Monticello, passed away early Monday morning at the home of a daughter, Mrs. Tony Niemann, Scales Mound, Ill., with whom she had been making her home in recent months.

Mrs. Miller had been in failing health for the past several years and a heart disease proved fatal.

Native of Albany

Julia Milbrandt was a daughter of August F. and Hannah Louise Lupke Milbrandt, both natives of Germany, and was born Oct. 24, 1876, in Albany. On Dec. 22, 1898, she was united in marriage to August Miller. They farmed for many years in Mt. Pleasant township, retiring in 1927 and moving to Monticello to make their home. Mr. Miller passed away Sept. 15, 1935, and since that time Mrs. Miller had been making her home with her children.

Mrs. Miller was a member of the Monticello Evangelical church and was an active member of its Ladies' Aid society.

She is survived by four daughters, Mrs. Niemann, Miss Lena Miller and Mrs. Esther Rhyner, Monroe, and Mrs. Ben Siegel, Apple River, Ill.; one son, Karl Miller, Clarno township; three brothers, Henry Milbrandt, Monticello, Herman Milbrandt, Monroe, and Charles Milbrandt, Troy, S. D.; and one sister, Mrs. Augusta Brecklien, Monroe. Seven grandchildren and two great-grandchildren also survive.
