1922 - April 27, 1930

Carl John Moritz, aged 8, son of Ernest J. Moritz, Washington township, passed away Sunday, April 27, 1930, in the Monroe hospital where he had been taken an hour before. His death was attributed to systematic poisoning, with which he had been ill for a week.

He was born in Washington township in 1922, the son of Ernest J. and Martha Ritschard Moritz. Ever since the death of his mother in 1924 he had made his home with his grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. John Moritz, Monticello.

Besides his father he is survived by his step-mother, one sister and one half-sister.
