Mrs, Sylvia Moritz, 57, Former Resident Of Monticello, Dies

Mrs. Sylvia Moritz, 57 years of age, native of Washington township and former Monticello resident, passed away at 9 Friday morning at the home of her son, Richard, Madison, With whom she had been living for a number of months.

Funeral services were held at 10:30 a. m. Monday in the Assembly of God church, Monroe. Rev. Gilman Hanson officiated, and burial was in the Reformation church cemetery, Washington township.

Mrs, Moritz, who had made her home in Monroe for a number of years, had been in failing health for some time.

The former Sylvia Arn, she was the daughter of Alfred and Marie Goodman Arn, natives of Switzerland. On Oct. 14, 1926, she was united in marriage to Ernest J. Moritz. They farmed in Washington township until 1931, when they moved to Monticello, where Mr. Moritz operated a tavern until his death Feb. 4, 1942.
