

Robert H. Naylor
1905 - July 29, 1984

Col. Robert H. Naylor, 78, a retired U. S. Army officer, Jackson, Miss., died Sunday, July 29, 1984 at Jackson.

He was born in Marion, Ind., and was a graduate of West Point in 1927, the Army Corp of Engineers, and served in World War II, in the Pacific Theatre, where he received the Legion of Merit and Bronze Star with Oak Leaf Cluster. He also taught military science and tactics at the UW-Madison during the 1930's.

He was married on Aug. 7, 1938, to Gladys Steinmann, Monticello. She died on June 7, 1978.

Survivors include his second wife, Jesse; one son, Col. Robert H. Naylor II, Fairfax, Va.; one daughter, Valerie Wintrich, Tucson, Ariz., and six grandchildren.

Services were held Saturday at Highland Cemetery, Monticello, with the Rev. Dr. Edward Lanphier of St. Andrew's Episcopal Church officiating.
